Laura Stack had flown 2 million miles around the world as a bestselling author of 8 books, until her world suddenly changed on Nov. 20, 2019, when her 19-year-old son, Johnny, died by suicide. He had become psychotic from dabbing high-THC marijuana concentrates. She responded by forming the nonprofit, Johnny's Ambassadors Youth Marijuana Prevention, to educate teens and parents about the dangers of marijuana on brain development, mental illness, and suicide.
