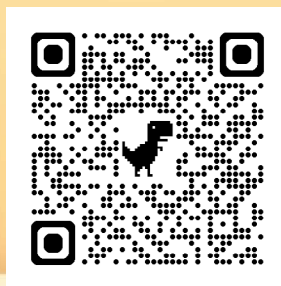
The ENTIRE COMMUNITY is invited: parents (and their older teens over 16), educators, healthcare and prevention professionals, legislators, community coalitions, law enforcement, and anyone who works with teens!

Most communities have seen a big increase in the use of THC products (vapes, dabs, edibles, marijuana) by youth over the past few years. Even in states where marijuana isn't legal, teens can buy intoxicating Delta-8 products made from hemp in gas stations.

This isn't the hippie weed you might remember from the 1960s. It's lab-designed, highly potent, and dangerous for the developing brains of young people. Unfortunately, many teens and parents are unaware of the harms and can think it's "just weed." But doctors say these new, high-potency THC products are responsible for a growing addiction, mental illness, behavioral problems, and psychotic episodes among teenage users.

As you know, lecturing and preaching doesn't work, so what does? Education. Laura Stack, the Founder of Johnny's Ambassadors, will give a one-hour presentation, followed by 30 minutes of Q&A and group discussion on what your community can do to prevent youth THC use.
